JENS ZERLE, from Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Bavaria, Germany: double bass, vocals.

DR. MILK, aka Ben Esen, from, Munich, Germany: percussion

THE BAVARIAN COWBOY, Uwe Schmidt, from Munich, Germany: electric guitar.
